

Call for Agricultural Pilots Project Pre-proposals

The Agricultural Pilots Project is accepting pre-proposals for innovative projects that demonstrate both improved income for agricultural producers and environmental benefit. For complete information on pre-proposal guidelines please visit www.pcc.wsu.edu.

Any group or individual who can meet the selection criteria and achieve the dual goals of the project is encouraged to apply, although agricultural producers are normally expected to be central partners in any pilot project.

Pre-proposal Guidelines

Application Due Date: October 20, 2006

Pre-proposals are to be **no longer than 5 pages** plus a one page budget summarizing the use of funds. Pre-proposals should include the following information:

- Applicant information including name, address, phone, e-mail, website (if any), project manager (if different from applicant).
- Description of the pilot project, including work to be completed, the expected outcomes for agricultural profitability, environmental improvements, and the opportunity for replicable or impact beyond the pilot effort.
- Name and affiliation of other partners in the project. The pre-proposal should also identify a technical partner or resource that will be available to help with data collection and evaluation of the pilot. (For assistance in locating a technical partner, please contact PCC Staff at agpilots@u.washington.edu).
- Estimated cost of the pilot, and funds expected from other sources and amount sought from the Agricultural Pilots Project.
- Include a budget page showing main categories of expenditures, and describe the use of the funds such as for technical assistance, agricultural inputs or equipment, etc.
