## FY 2009 Water Quality Funding Programs Workshops

From Ecology's Water Quality Program

The Washington State Department of Ecology (Ecology) invites you to participate in public workshops during the month of September 2007. Ecology staff will discuss and help you with the water quality loan and grant application process for state fiscal year 2009 (FY 2009). This workshop also includes two concurrent afternoon breakout sessions to provide specific technical assistance for nonpoint activity projects and facility projects.

Funds will be available from the Centennial Clean Water Fund (Centennial), the federal Clean Water Act Section 319 Nonpoint Source Fund (319), and the Washington State Water Pollution Control Revolving Fund programs (Revolving Fund). **Applications for funding consideration will be accepted from September 1, 2007, through October 31, 2007.**
