

# END OF 2011 2<sup>nd</sup> SPECIAL SESSION REPORT



## Purpose

This report, prepared by the Washington Association of County Officials (WACO) has two main purposes:

1. Informing County Officials of RCW changes made during the 2011 2<sup>nd</sup> Special Legislative Session of the Washington State Legislature; and
2. Inform County Officials of legislation that was introduced during the 2011 2<sup>nd</sup> Special Legislative Session that did not pass. Note that bills that were introduced in the 2011 Regular Legislative Session, the 2011 1<sup>st</sup> Special Session, and the 2011 2<sup>nd</sup> Special Session that did not pass are all eligible for consideration and adoption during the 2012 Regular Legislative Session (and any subsequent 2012 Special Session(s)).

This report covers bills from the 2011 2<sup>nd</sup> Special Session and is current as of Thursday, December 15, 2011.
