

## LEGISLATIVE STEERING COMMITTEE (LSC)

The LSC, as it is fondly referred to, is the Association's mechanism for setting WSAC's legislative priorities for each session, and it works on the issues with the executive branch agencies and through the legislative process. The committee is made up of a cross section of the WSAC membership, appointed annually by the president and is co-chaired by two members. Every member county is granted at least one position on the LSC. Each year, the LSC updates and submits to the general membership for approval a comprehensive set of policies and positions designed to guide both WSAC staff and its members during the legislative session. The LSC leads member involvement throughout the legislative session to call and visit legislators and assist in the successful implementation of WSAC's legislative agenda.

The LSC may designate and dissolve sub-committees (sometimes referred to as work groups) as it deems necessary.

For 2011-2012 the sub-committee slate includes:

- General Government
- Health & Human Services
- Land Use
- Natural Resources & Environment
- Public Safety
- Transportation
- Public Health

These sub-committees are open to the general membership and members may participate in as many as they wish.
